We recognise that a sense of belonging can have a powerful influence on an individual's behaviour and motivation, their physical, social and mental well-being and in turn their willingness to put themselves forward and take on new challenges.

As such the creation of spaces where everyone feels welcome, feels safe and is able to be themselves is critically important if we are to create new possibilities for people to achieve through netball.

Our aim is to take a lead role in the development of supportive and inclusive spaces, embedding and challenging best practice to deliver enhanced outcomes.

We will:

- Support consultation and co-designing when creating inclusive spaces with communities, including journeys to and from the spaces.
- Build organisational capacity in the areas of safeguarding and inclusion within these spaces.
- Promote equal and inclusive leadership.
- Advocate for policy and culture development.
