Netball World Cup Sydney 2027 Qualifier Oceania Available Globally

World Netball (WN) has today announced that the Netball World Cup Sydney 2027 (NWC2027) Qualifier Oceania will be available globally, with international fans able to watch live and on demand on [NetballPass*](#).

The event will take place from 14th – 18th September 2026 at the Tonga High School Indoor Stadium with the hosts, Tonga, welcoming Cook Islands, Fiji, Papua New Guinea, and Samoa.

The top two teams at the end of the competition will be invited by WN to compete at the [NWC2027](#), which is taking place from 25th August – 5th September 2027.

All those outside of Tonga will be able to watch every match live and on demand on NetballPass, whilst those in Tonga will be able to follow all the action live via TBC, on Television Tonga and Radio Tonga.
